

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is 25 inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the fork eye. Some makers would differ the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
